

WHAT YOU'LL NEED


- Printer
- 8 ½ x 11 white printer paper (for printing the template)
- Masking tape
- Assorted color markers: if students are coloring the mural
- Colorful sticky notes: if students are adding sticky notes to complete the mural
- Pens: for students to write messages

INSTRUCTIONS


- Print the following pages on 8 ½ x 11 printer paper
- Organized the pages face down to create the image shown below
- Please note: there will be a border between each section
- Use masking tape on the back of the sheets to join the sections of the template
- Hang on the wall image side facing out
- Students can use markers and/or add sticky notes to the template to customize the mural












